

These AlMontar terminal statistics have been collected in full collaboration with AlMontar authorities; mainly representative offices of Ministry of Interior, Ministry of Civil Affairs and Ministry of National Economy. The presented statistics cover 5 days of actual operating days (mostly partial) during the period of April 1st to April 14th 2006.

Notes:

- The terminal was closed for 7 days for imports and 9 days for exports during the reporting period.
- Agricultural goods, garments, and furniture were the main types of goods exported through the terminal during this period.
- The area "0" which is used for import of bulk goods has been reopened.
- The area "34" which is used for aggregates and containers has been reopened for aggregates .
- The average daily export volumes of imports/exports and average daily utilization are well below the averages prior to January /February/March closure periods, this is due to repeated closures during the reporting period and the fact not all terminal capacity has been utilized even on the operating days.
- AlMontar operates weekly from Sunday to Friday, Saturday is the weekly holiday however the terminal still works on Saturdays on imports of aggregates from Israel.
